ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

First-Time Freshmen (High School Graduates)

- Minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) and an 18 on the ACT or 950 on the SAT (combined ERW & Math) or a cumulative GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale).
- In addition to the requirements listed above, freshmen must have completed the following units of high school credits: 4 English, 3 Social Studies, 4 Mathematics, 3 Lab Sciences, 1 Arts, and 2 Foreign Language

NO APPLICATION FEE

Transfer Students

- Students who wish to transfer to WLU from another college or university must be eligible to return to the institution from which they wish to transfer.
- Minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) - an official transcript must be sent directly from all institutions attended
- Evidence of honorable withdrawal from the institution previously attended (Transfer Clearance Form)
